SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES, RULES & REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY

- Attend a public, private, or home school and live within the BISD/CISD Boundaries for no fewer than two academic years at the time of the award.
- Potentially participate in an impromptu interview as a part of the final selection process for this scholarship if chosen to do so.
- Have applied to a college, university, trade school, or other institution of higher education for enrollment in the Fall following graduation from high school.
- Award winners must meet all graduation requirements to be eligible to receive the scholarship award.
- Award winners must submit a copy of a letter of admission and proof of college registration to an accredited school or college of higher learning to the Wild Game Dinner Scholarship Committee to be eligible to receive payment of the scholarship award. Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the School, College, or University in the recipient's name. It is the responsibility of the recipient to ensure that tuition is paid in full by the deadline set forth by the School, College, or University.
- The Kendall County Wild Game Dinner, Inc. does not discriminate based on race, color, religion, sex, nationality, or ethnic origin in the administration of any of its policies or procedures.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

- The application must be fully completed; incomplete applications will not be considered.
- A photocopy of test scores and official school transcript must accompany the application.
- Obtain three recommendation letters from a teacher, counselor, school official, etc. Recommender must be a non-family member.
- Parent signatures are mandatory.

TIMELINE

- Scholarship applications will be available by January 16, 2024, online and at the Kendall County Extension Office, 118 Saunders St., Boerne, Texas 78006.
- Applications are due no later than March 15, 2023.
- The Winner will be publicly announced at the recipients 2023 Scholarship Award Ceremonies and/or at other venues as deemed appropriate by the Kendall County Wild Game Dinner.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- All decisions of the Scholarship Committee and the judges are final.
- All applications and results remain the property of the Kendall Co. Jr. Livestock Association's Wild Game Dinner Scholarship Committee and shall not be accessible to the public. No Exceptions.
- No late applications will be accepted. No Exceptions.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- To have the right to receive funds after being awarded a scholarship, the scholarship recipient must provide proof of acceptance to a college, university, trade school or other institution of higher learning and proof of enrollment at the same time or before a request is made for distribution of scholarship funds.
- All scholarship funds will only be paid directly to the college, university, trade school or institution of higher learning.
